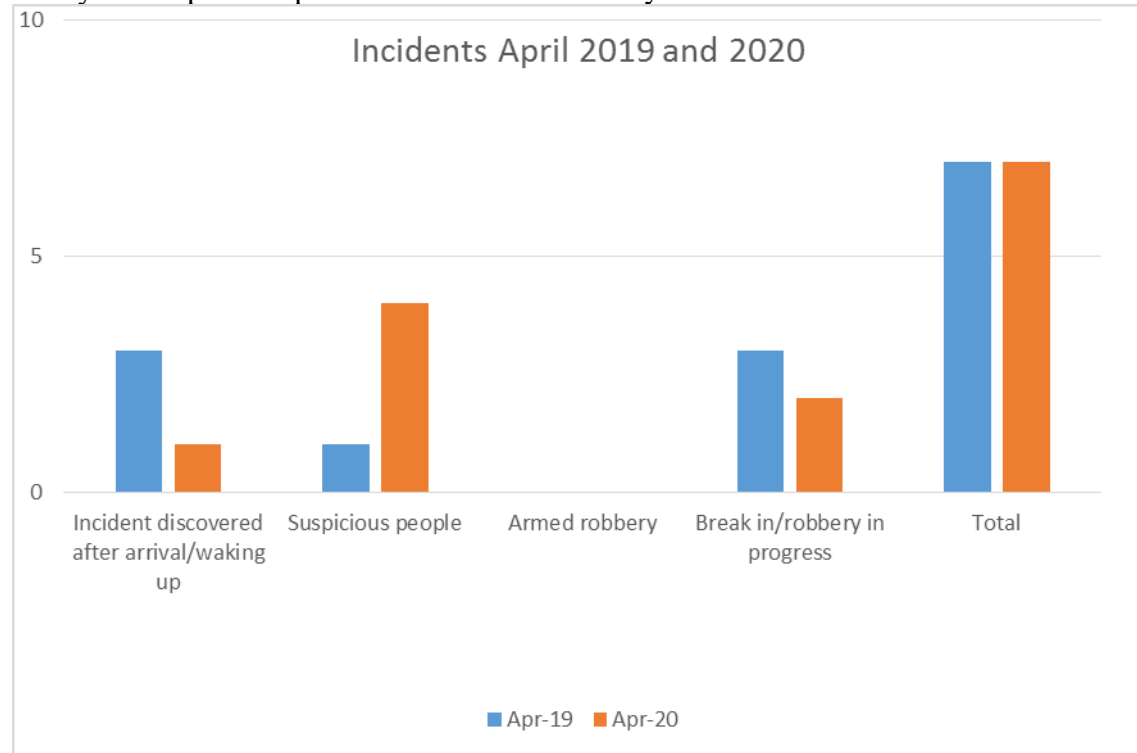

This year's April compared to the same time last year:



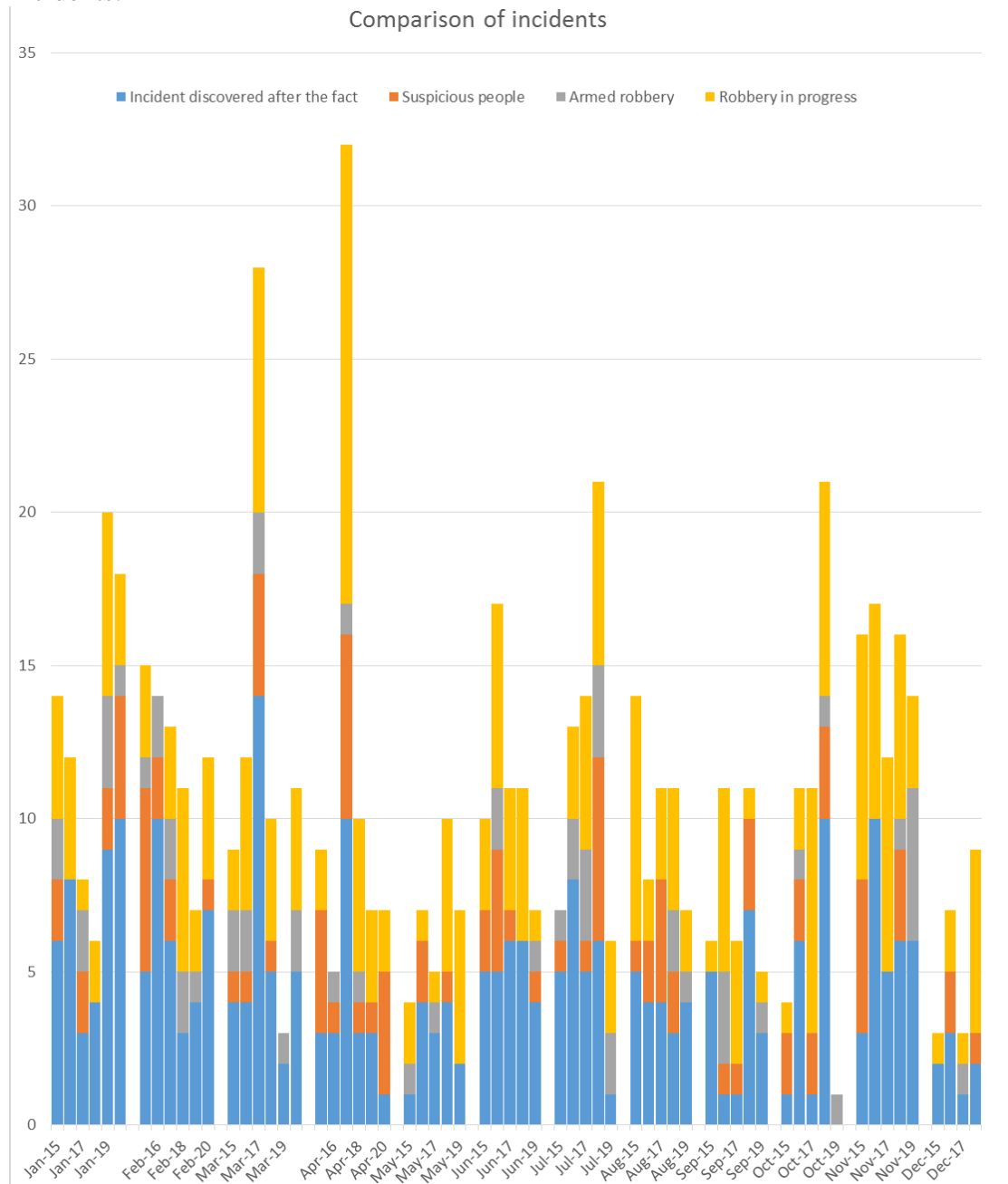

DATE	LOCATION	TYPE	DESCRIPTION
04/04/2020	BEREA WEST (<360)	Break-in: attempted	Early this morning (it was a rainy night/day) someone tried to break open the gate of this house.
17/04/2020	DEVENISH DRIVE	Suspicious vehicle	Silver Polo, 3 BM white shirts, driving very slowly
19/04/2020	ORMONDE STREET	Cable/man hole cover related	Theft in early morning hours around 04:00. Gate light cut off and stolen.
19/04/2020	DEVENISH DRIVE	Suspicious vehicle	suspicious vehicle parked at Devenisch. Security companies given registration number but car drove off when noticed. Two occupants. Silver Mercedes.
20/04/2020	LOVEDAY STREET	Suspicious vehicle	Unknown car in the driveway, Green Adi with tinted windows. When approached it drove away. Community tried to trace it by looking out the windows (coronatime), but nothing found..
20/04/2020	DOUGALL STREET	Suspicious vehicle	When looking for the above, a black Mercedes was spotted driving down Dougall, saw people being on the look out and turned around. Community gave shase and stopped him to ask what he was doing in the neighbourhood (corona time) After police checked, vehcle wasn't stolen or suspicious. Owner got a warning to get the papers in order..
27/04/2020	BOURKE STREET	Break-in: with theft	Cat burglar on roof, 2 nights in a row. First night a hose pipe was stolen. This night, owners managed to chase him away. No description known
