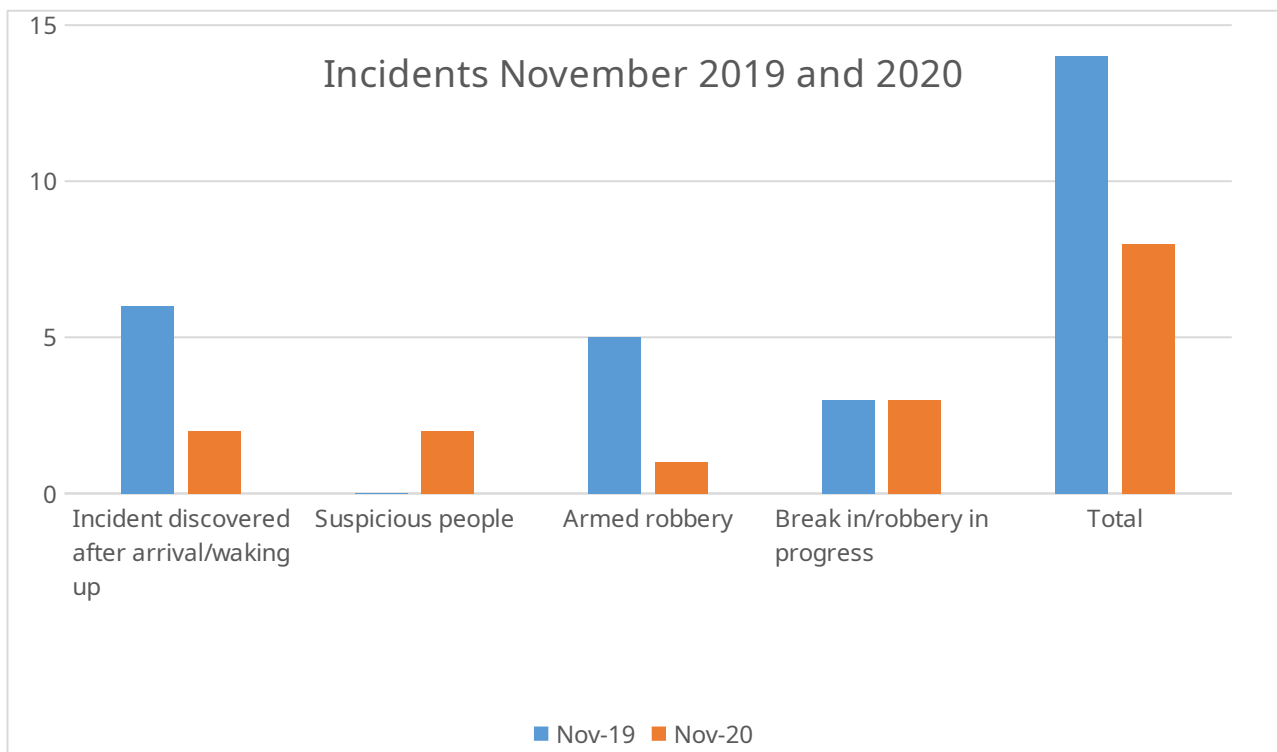


Good day all.

For November 2020, we had **8 incidents reported**. We had 3 break-ins, one theft of equipment off the back of a vehicle, one theft of a tv, 1 theft of a dustbin, 1 **armed robbery**(cellphones+laptops), and 2 incidents of a suspicious persons.

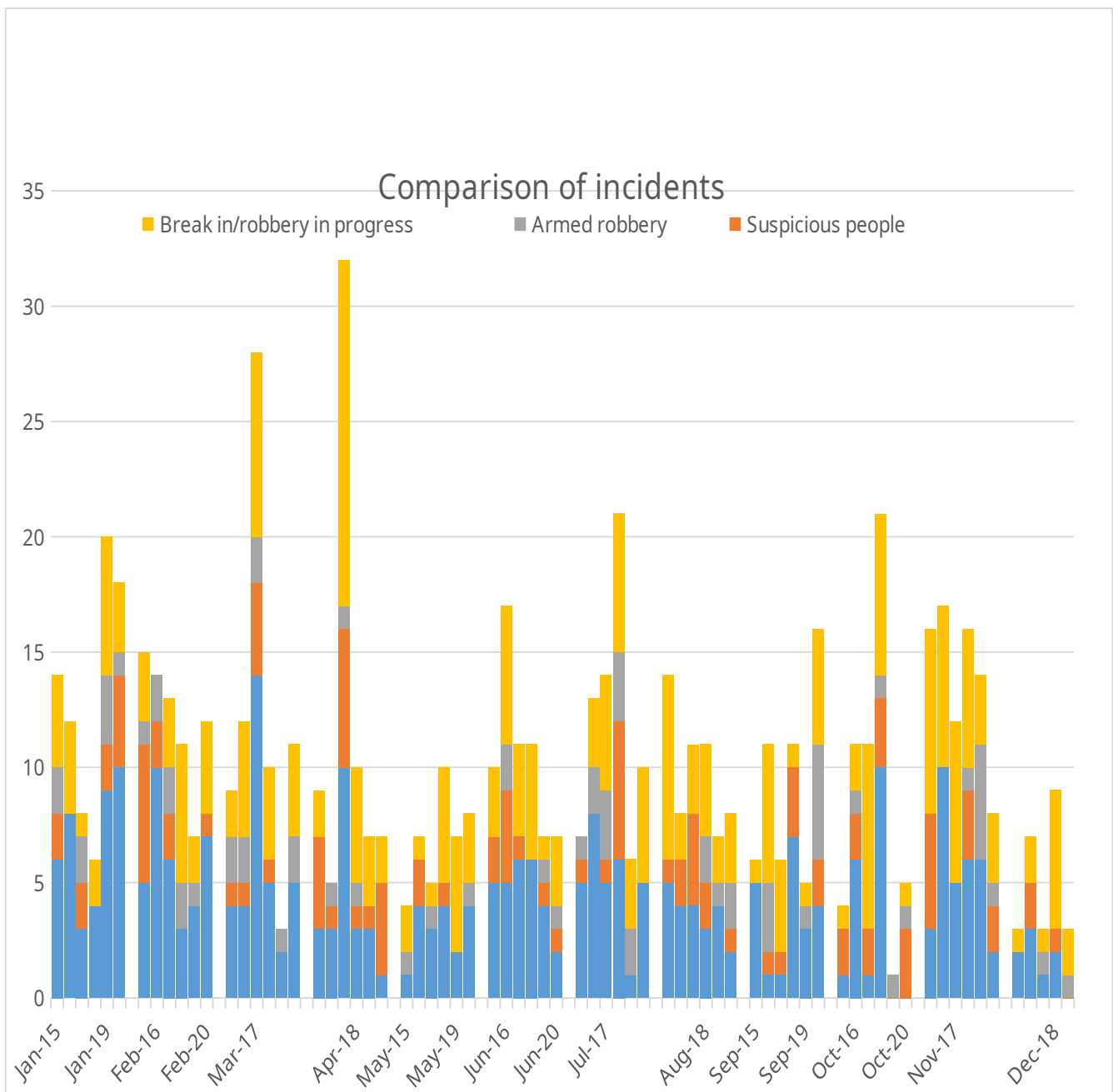

DATE	AREA	TYPE	DESCRIPTION
02/11/2020	WILLEM PUNT AVENUE	Suspicious people	Around 13:00 a bottle green Kia was driving around Willem punt street, around no. 321, and took photos of the house with a cellphone.
14/11/2020	LOVEDAY STREET	Armed robbery	3 Armed BM jumped over wall. The 2 -3 kids that were home got robbed of laptops + cell phones. Robbers got away (by car).
16/11/2020	SILVER STREET	Suspicious people	White car BNH 290 GP with 1 BM stood for a while on pavement with cell phone in his hands. Might have taken pictures.
21/11/2020	BEREA EAST (360+)	Theft of dustbin	An intruder was on the property. The dogs heard something and were upset. <i>They moved a rubbish bin into an alley next to a boundary wall. A second similar rubbish bin is missing and the black bag of rubbish neatly left behind in a corner. Nothing further is missing.</i>
21/11/2020	ORMONDE STREET	Suspicious	Owner in Ormonde Street had similar incident with dustbin in alley etc as previous incident.
21/11/2020	SIBELIUS STREET	Off premises incident	Suspicion that someone had fiddled with the outside water meter.
25/11/2020	LEYDS STREET	Break-in: theft	Break-in at this guest house. A wide screen tv was reported stolen

26/11/ 2020	DOUGALL STREET	Break-in: theft	Small truck was parked in the drive way, gate closed. Spades and more were stolen from the load body. Dogs barked at that time of night, but owner didn't see anything.
