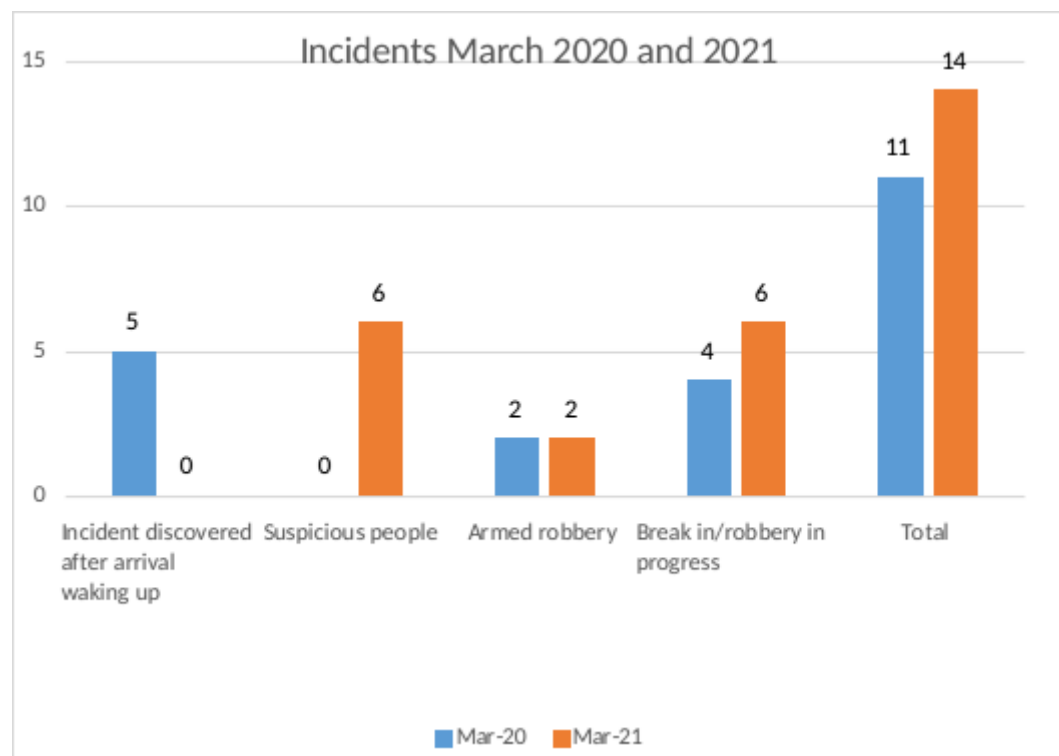


Good day all.

For March 2021, we had **14 incidents reported**. We had 6 break-ins/robberies (cell phones, laptops), 6 incidents of a suspicious persons and 2 armed robberies. Of the armed robberies one was at a home and one occurred on the street.

March stats

There is a very slight increase in crime compared to last year:



This month has seen a continued attempts **at entering properties while people are driving into our out of their yards are gardeners are busy outside the yard.**

Also, people are being robbed in the morning when walking through Muckleneuk.

Crime is slightly higer than the lower levels we saw in 2019 but not as bad as spikes we saw in 2017 and 2018.

Comparison of total incidents during the years we have been keeping track of incidents:

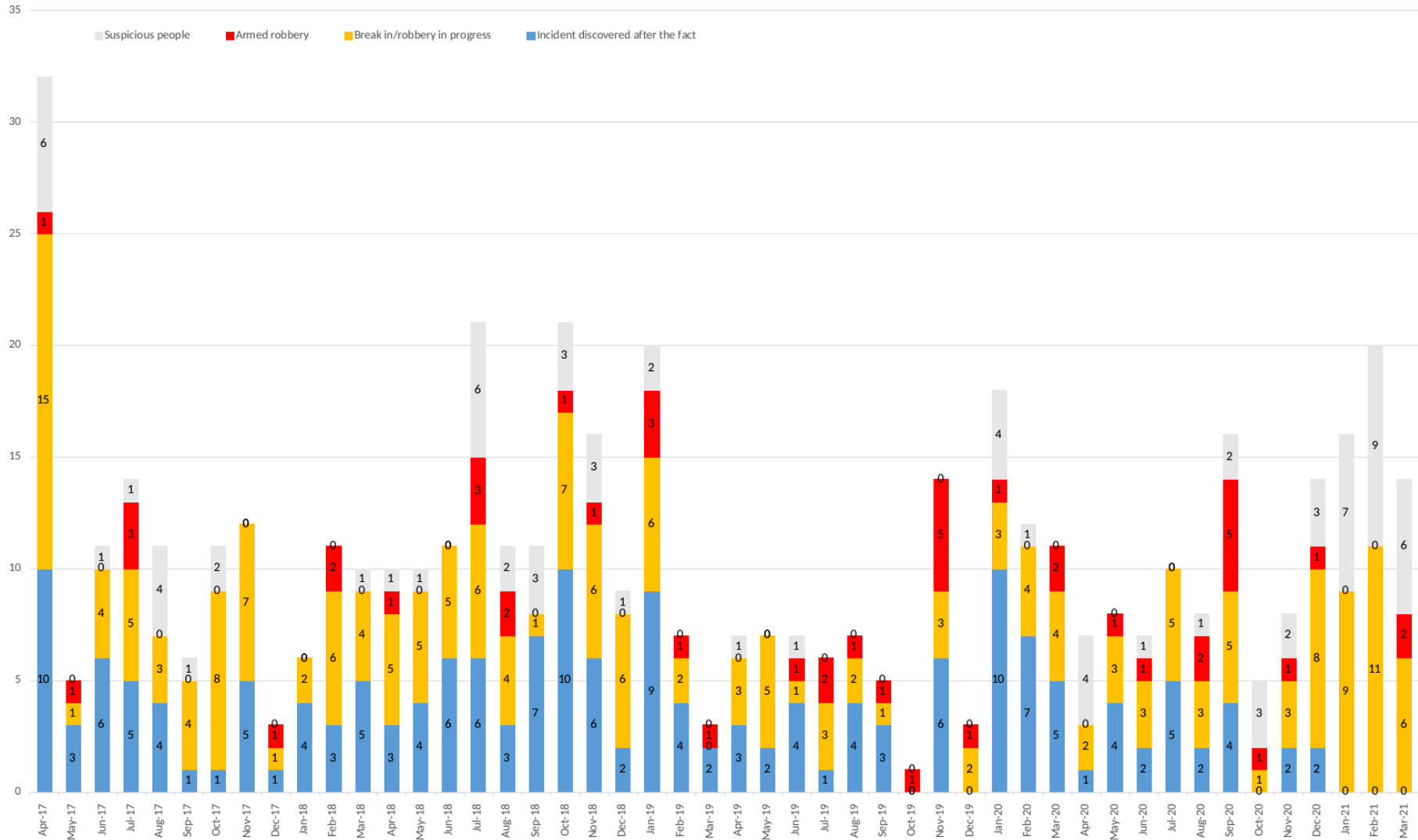

Date	Area	Type	Mapped Type for Summary	Description
2/3/2021	SIBELIUS STREET	Theft: without break-in	Break in/robbery in progress	Student from Crawford was robbed of her cell phone
4/3/2021	Ridge Street	Theft: without break-in	Break in/robbery in progress	A domestic worker walking to work was robbed of her phone and some belongings in Ridge street below Unisa.
5/3/2021	ST. PATRICKS ROAD	Robbery: confirmed	Armed robbery	Gardener was mowing the lawn in front and the garage door was open, 2 or 3 BM stopped their car (Hyundai i10 HY 82 CM GP) and came in. Told the people to keep quiet and not make a noise or they will shoot. Asked about tracking devices in the car and panic buttons and then took what they wanted at gun point. They were so quiet that a person in the flat did not hear them. Stolen BMW X3 dark blue HT47JBGP
9/3/2021	DOUGALL STREET	Followed home with robbery	Break in/robbery in progress	A resident heard somebody scream, went outside and saw a lady whose cell phone had just been grabbed from her. The lady said that she opened her gate when the incident occurred. They then

				went to the park next to the Jacaranda Hospital looking for the perpetrator, but could not identify him. The police drove by, stopped and the incident was reported to them and the statement of the victim taken.
9/3/2021	DOUGALL STREET	Suspicious people	.	This is an unoccupied property and resident next door noticed damages to the fence and bags with stuff in the property. There had been three vagrants earlier in the day, but they were nowhere to be seen.
9/3/2021	SMITH STREET	Break-in: with theft	Break in/robbery in progress	The owner noticed a perpetrator in her yard stealing a bicycle, and she alerted security. When security arrived, the perpetrator was gone. He was short, with a brown jacket and a red T shirt.
17/03/2021	SMITH STREET	Break-in: attempted	Suspicious people	It was seen on owners security camera's that there were 2 BM coming through the plants towards the wall / garage bounding the property. It was obvious they were discussing how to get in. After a few minutes they left. A little bit later it was reported on the telegram group. An other resident recognised one of them, sitting yesterday crn Smith / Kruin checking out the neighbourhood.
17/03/2021	LUKAS STREET	Suspicious vehicle	Suspicious people	Footage came through about 5 vehicles parking close to Kruin Park gate 3. Drivers and passengers changed seats. A little while later a police helicopter in the sky, looking for them.

18/03/2021	SIBELIUS STREET	Break-in: attempted	Suspicious people	Dogs were barking excessively early in the morning. Later the owners found the gate being forced open.
18/03/2021	SILVER STREET	Suspicious people	Suspicious people	Owner discovered big knuckle bones had been thrown over the gate. Took bones and dogs to vet. Vet says was definitely poisoned bones
18/03/2021	FLORENCE RIBEIRO AVENUE	Robbery: confirmed	Armed robbery	Corner Florence Ribeiro and Nicholson str at the robot a lady was approached by a guy with a gun and he took her cell phone and walked away.
18/03/2021	ST. PATRICKS ROAD	Robbery: attempted	Suspicious people	White Polo reg HW 48GX GP and a small black car tried to follow the wife into the driveway. Husband was in the driveway and when they saw him they drove away. Red Car Possibly a Renault. Reg no. JB 80 TC GP could be a possible spotter car that was seen in the area. The white Polo has been involved in an armed robbery in Clubview earlier in the week.
22/03/2021	SMITH STREET	Break-in: no theft	Break in/robbery in progress	Residents were inside the house when they heard the garden beams going off. They saw a BM strawling in the garden. Resident phoned neighbour, who called it in on the radio. The neighbour saw the perpetrator jumping over the wall into his driveway. He followed the perpetrator, but lost him somewhere towards SS. Perpetrator was obviously hiding, because a little while later he suddenly appeared and an other

28/03/2021	Smith	Theft: without break-in	Break in/robbery in progress	Some one sneaked in while the gate was open. Tenant saw a guy running out, could not identify or take photo. Laptop was stolen.
