

With our increasing ability to track vehicles in our area with our cameras, MHSI in conjunction with various security companies, was involved in various tactical initiatives (which was kept under wraps for obvious reasons) in an attempt to trap and or apprehend this vehicle.

The morning of 11 May this vehicle was spotted in Centurion. The vehicle was followed to the Mall at Reds shopping mall where effective co-operation between Fidelity ADT, Axon and SAPS apprehended the suspects. Two African males were arrested and two unlicensed firearms were recovered.


Comparison of total incidents during the years
